First Steps

Bathroom

- Dispose of any trash
- Remove all linens for cleaning Return quest belongings to Guest Services for lost and found logging
- Lock all windows
- Check supplies and replace as needed
- Remove all cobwebs with broom (check high/low, interior/exterior)
- Clean all high-touch areas (doorknobs, light switches, etc.)
- Clean all glass and mirrors
- Spot clean doors and walls as needed

- Clean all cabinets, inside and out
- Clean and sanitize the shower area. including tub, wall, rod and fixtures; check for hair and soap scum/mold
- Inspect shower curtain liner and change as needed (at least 2x/month)
- Draw the shower curtain closed



- As needed, wash and dry dishware/cookware/flatware/utensils
- Clean backsplash and stove vent
- Clean interior of microwave and refrigerator (oven only as needed)
- Clean appliance exteriors: microwave, refrigerator, oven (including drip pans and knobs), dishwasher, etc.

Living Room

Initials

- Vacuum upholstery/wipe leather
- Dust (or clean as needed) all tables and other flat surfaces

- Decrumb toaster as needed
- Clean all cabinets and drawers. reorganize if necessary
- Clean kitchen table and chairs
- Clean all counters
- Clean sink and dish drainer



- Clean and disinfect any entertainment devices and remotes
- Wipe TV with dry microfiber cloth
- Fireplace: clean glass, mantle, and hearth

Exterior Cleaning

- Clean dining table and chairs
- As needed, brush off or clean other furniture

- Vacuum on/beneath all doormats
- Sweep only: no need to mop

Bedroom(s)

- Initials Clean headboard
- Clean dressers, tables, and any other furniture, including drawers
- Clean and disinfect any entertainment devices and remotes
- Wipe TV with dry microfiber cloth
- Vacuum upholstery, wipe leather
- Clean closet hangers

- Loft: Clean any

Last Steps

- Reset the thermostat: if occupied within a day set to 72. If unoccupied for more than a day, set to 68 heat or 78 AC
- Set all clocks display the correct time
- Set all televisions to an appropriate channel and volume
- Put yourself in the quest's shoes: is there anything else that needs cleaning? Would your family be comfortable here?



- Restage furniture/rugs
- Mop on your way out
- Lock doors
- Report any issues to maintenance
- Report any damage/loss to supervisor
